## Points Given at Each Tour Stop

$1^{\text {st }}-4$ Points<br>$2^{\text {nd }}-3$ Points<br>$3^{\text {rd }}-2$ Points<br>All Participants - 1 Point

Tour Champions Rules

1. Points awarded when there is a tie in the standings - Ties for $1^{\text {st }}$ Place will be broken in a manner determined by the tournament director. For all other ties, each player will receive the designated number of points.

Example 1. Three players tie for $2^{\text {nd }}-$ All players will receive 3 points. The next position is $5^{\text {th }}$ and will receive 1 point.

Example 2. Three players tie for $3^{\text {rd }}$ - All players will receive 2 points.
2. Participation to win- Players do not have to participate in every tour event to win the tour championship. Most points over the three points wins.
3. Tie for Tour Champion Once the Three Tournaments Are Completed - If players are tied in the points standings after the three tour events, the player with the highest finish in the final event of the tour will be declared champion. If still tied the following tie breaker will be in effect.

- Best Finish in North Carolina State Championship
- Best Finish in Tennessee State Pro Mini Golf Open
- Best Finish in Putters League Mid-Summer Classic
- Scorecard Playoff - NC State Championship $5^{\text {th }}, 4^{\text {th }}$ and so on
- Scorecard Playoff - TN Pro Mini Golf Open $5^{\text {th }}, 4^{\text {th }}$ and so on
- Scorecard Playoff - Putter League Mid-Summer Classic $5^{\text {th }}, 4^{\text {th }}$ and so on
- Sudden Death Playoff Hole 18 at Lakeview Putt \& Play
- Coin Flip
